<u>Summary</u>

Mark is a certified Siebel consultant (versions 5.5, 6 and 7) and has a wealth of experience in versions 3.1 through to 8.2, including OpenUI and IP17+. He is also a certified Pega System Architect (PCSA) and has completed a number of Salesforce training modules including Salesforce Admin (beginner, intermediate & advanced) and Developer.

Mark has worked on many Siebel horizontals (Sales, Service, Call Centre, Marketing, etc) as well as a number of verticals including Public Sector, Financial Services and eCommunciations. Mark has over 30 years experience in systems development, with over 25 of those years in Siebel. He has worked as Technical/Development lead on 15+ full life cycle projects, the majority of which were Siebel projects. He has led teams of up to 8 people from design through to development and implementation.

Mark's key strengths are in design and problem solving, as well as hands on development. He prides himself on producing high quality and robust deliverables, employing best practices and promoting the sharing of information amongst team members.
